Pruning as an Integrated Pest Management Tool –

Class will focus on the proper ways to prune various types of plants, including trees, shrubs, and vines, to improve plant health in the landscape. This class will focus on the implementation of pruning practices in the landscape, so please come prepared with a good pair of hand pruners.
