

## Materials for Making Plant Vouchers:

Plant press: newspaper, cardboard layers (referred to as ventilators)
Thick blotting paper (optional)
Dried plants

Pruners/clippers/scissors for trimming plants

Newspaper or material for covering work surface

Acid-free Mounting Paper - we use 11-1/2" x16-1/2" size

Cloth tape - we use ½" gummed linen and cut down to size as needed Acid-free Glue - we use Rollataq 300 Adhesive

Paint brushes for applying glue

Q-tips - helpful for wetting tape, cleaning up excess water or glue

Tweezers and/or toothpicks for handling fragile plant parts

Labels - make your own or order printed labels Clear display sleeves/covers to seal vouchers in Desiccant packets (optional) Storage bins (optional)
