State Fair Feed, monitor calf health daily Continue to provide calf feed/quality hay after weaning to ensure proper nutrition and growth Be present during pre-scheduled health assessments (on site visits) Surrender calf to Dairy Beef Feeder Calf Program Committee if the committee determines there is a lack of proper feeding and health management contributing to poor animal performance Follow BQA Standards/Rules/Regulations Promptly alert project committee if any problems (sickness) arise Immediately notify WNC Dairy Beef Feeder Calf Program Committee if participant decides to withdraw from project and return supplies/surrender calf to WNC Dairy Beef Feeder Calf Program Committee if choosing to withdraw from project at any time prior to final sale of calf Attend ALL MANDATORY scheduled meetings and workshops Pay any veterinary bills beyond WNC Dairy Beef Feeder Calf Program Committee expertise.
